

Criteria for applying to the 20th Anniversary fund

Who can apply?

Applicants can be individuals including Wrekin housing trust employees, community groups, a church or school as long as it is for the community.

In order to apply for funding you must have a bank account.

Exemptions for applying to the community fund are:

- What you are applying for are core services of the Wrekin housing trust or the local authority
- They are statutory services provided by the Trust or local authority
- They do not meet the Wrekin housing trust's charitable objectives
- The group/organisation have not received any funding from the Wrekin Housing Trust in the last 12 months.

How much can I apply for?

The limit for each project is up to £1000. As part of the funding agreement the Trust should receive a short report on what the money was spent on, receipts and any photographs will need to be included in the report.

All projects/activities must be completed within 12 months of receiving the funding.

What happens next?

The individual or group need to complete the application form within this pack and return it to the Wrekin Housing Trust, either by email
